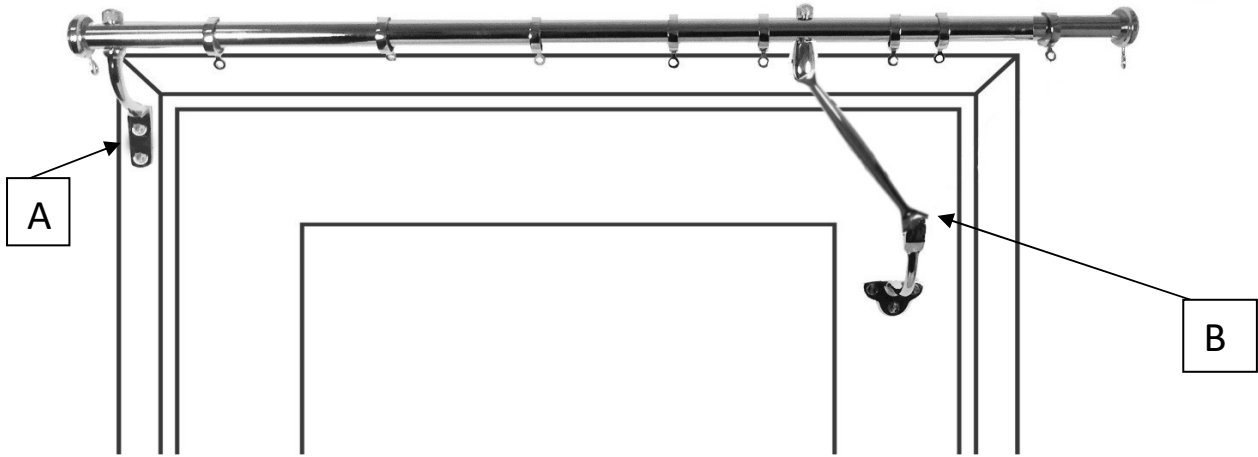

Broughtons Rising Portiere Rod Fitting instructions



Contents:

- 1 Rod
- 1 Architrave Bracket (A)
- 1 Door Cranked Bracket (B)
- 2 End Caps
- 10 Rings

1. The Broughtons Portiere Rod is suitable for inward opening doors hinged either way (either hand) for a light-to-medium weight curtain.
2. The rod can be shortened with a suitable saw BUT it must be from the rod end that does not have the hole drilled through.
3. Fix support bracket "A" to the top of the door jamb/frame on the hinged side of the door (inside the room).
4. Assemble the rod to the support bracket "B" using the bolt provided, to the hole nearest the centre of the rod.
IMPORTANT NOTE: When attaching the knurled bolt, please only finger-tighten, as overtightening may distort impact on operation.
5. Slide approximately 7 Rings on to the longer end of the rod and attach one of the end caps.
6. Attach the rod to the (already fitted) bracket "A" and with the door closed, screw the Bracket "B" to the door as shown ensuring the Arm is at approximately 45deg to the vertical, this will allow the rod to rise when operated.
7. Slide on the remaining rings to the shorter end of the rod and attach the other end cap.
8. Fix your curtain/drape to the ring eyelets.
